FE & HE Taster Days

Taster Days at Leeds College of Art introduce students to skills and techniques and provide an opportunity to experience some of the specialist facilities at the College. Taster Days usually run from 9.30am - 2.30pm and include a tour of the College. Materials are provided and all Taster Days are free of charge.



Jewellery / Metal (Blenheim Walk)

Students work in specialist metal workshops where they will be introduced to some of the hand skills that are used, such as sawing, annealing and applying texture to metal. Students will develop a personal design and make a piece of jewellery or a small scale sculptural object to take away with them.

A cultural visit with follow-up work

Sequential activities involve a visit to an art gallery or museum followed by development work at Leeds College of Art. Sequential projects usually involve a minimum of three sessions and are devised and planned in conjunction with school art staff to support the National Curriculum. Past projects have involved drawing, printmaking, glass fusing and ceramics work inspired by visits to the Tutankhamen exhibition at the O2 (London), the David Nash exhibition at the West Yorkshire Sculpture Park and The Deep (Hull).

We will be recruiting a maximum of 30 students from High Schools in Leeds and are looking for students who are prepared to make a commitment to attending the whole course.

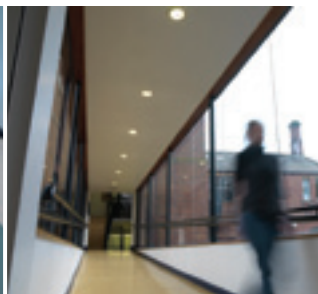
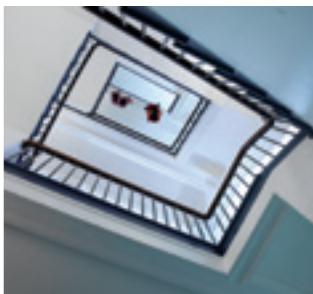
