It is a part of a growing portfolio of opportunities for postgraduate study at Leeds Arts University, which includes an MA in Curation Practices, along with an MA Graphic Design, MA Photography and MA Fine Art for entry in 2019.

Postgraduate students at Leeds Arts University will be based in the University's new build expansion to the existing Blenheim Walk site, which includes access to a dedicated research and reference library and a new postgraduate study suite. The new build will also house a larger gallery space, performance auditorium and coffee shop, allowing the public to enjoy an exciting and varied events and exhibitions programme at the University.
