Leeds College of Art present their inaugural MA Creative Practice exhibition at Munro House Gallery; produced, curated, and delivered by the first four postgraduate students of this exciting new course.

The exhibition runs from 10th October to 8th November and showcases an inspiring collection of work which is of exceptional quality, imagination and technical skill. The work exhibited explores the intersection between researched contextualisation, personal practice and current events and involves a cross section of interdisciplinary art united through creative practice.

The four artists exhibiting include [Emma Dexter](#), a sculpture visual/installation artist, [Andres Jaroslavsky](#), a self-taught figurative painter, [Patrick Kirk-Smith](#), who specialises in performance and text and [Janey Walklin](#), who specialises in printmaking and collage.

The exhibition is not to be missed. Open to the public, there is something for everyone at this exhibition, whether you are a fully-fledged artist, undergraduate student, thinking of doing an MA Creative Practice or just passionate about art! Works will include exceptional large scale paintings representing Argentina's last dictatorship to extraordinary sculpture pieces.

The MA Creative Practice has been devised for creative practitioners; recent graduates and professionals who wish to examine, strengthen and deepen their art and design practice. It addresses the needs of graduates in art and design, who want to continue to develop their practice; develop their identities in the context of the creative and cultural industries; maintain contact with other creative practitioners; develop freelance or other career paths in the context of a portfolio career.
